"Success is achieved by ordinary people with extraordinary determination".

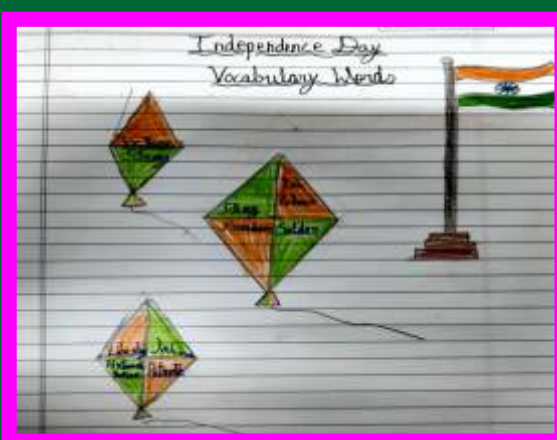
