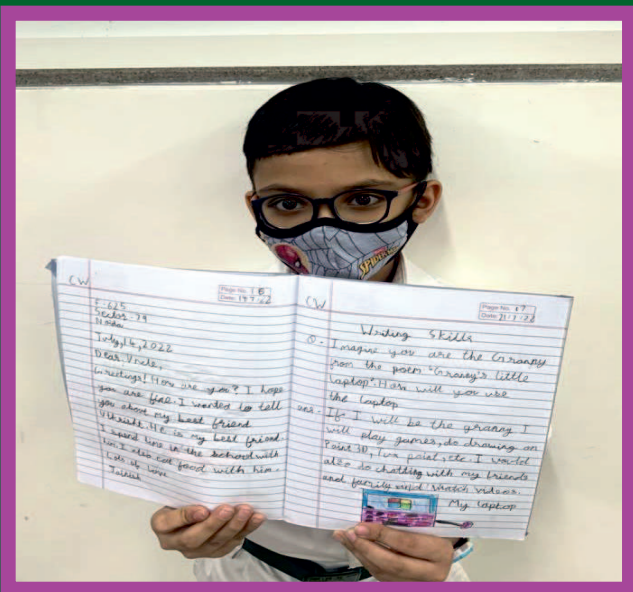
Together We Can, Together We Will
